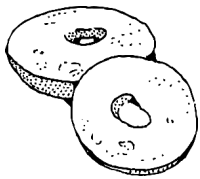
REGISTRATION for High Holy Days is available until the last service on Yom Kippur. Member tickets will be mailed. Non-member orders will be acknowledged via email (or regular mail for those who do not have email). Non-member tickets will be available at Will Call during High Holy Days.

CHILDCARE requires registration using the form below or the form on the website. Childcare is available Erev Rosh Hashanah, both days of Rosh Hashanah, Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur Day.

PARENTS MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN TO CHILDCARE.

Please sign in your child, introduce yourself and your child to a childcare provider, and let them know how long you plan to stay.

We provide snacks, but please feel free to bring a preferred snack.



BREAK-THE-FAST – At the end of Yom Kippur, our Break-the-Fast takes place immediately following Havdalah, which will be at approximately 7:45 pm.

FOOD DRIVE Please bring canned or packaged nonperishable food for our annual food drive between Rosh Hashanah and Simchat Torah. Donations go to the San Francisco-Marin Food Bank.



ANNUAL APPEAL - Donations are key to the vitality of our shul. Donations to our annual High Holy Day Appeal comprise a full 10% of our budget. Please feel free to donate when you register for High Holy Days, or use the member pledge form you receive at Kol Nidre services on October 8. SWEET GREETINGS FUNDRAISER - Use the registration form to send a Rosh Hashanah greeting card and special honey treat to B'nai Emunah congregants or to your family and friends outside the congregation. This Sisterhood fundraiser is easy and fun and helps fund congregational programs. Here's how it works:

- For \$180, send a greeting to all members of the congregation.
- For \$9 each, send a greeting to individual congregants.
- For \$18 each, purchase additional personalized greeting cards and gifts to give to friends and family outside the congregation. These cards and gifts may be picked up at B'nai Emunah on or after Rosh Hashanah so you can deliver them at your convenience.



YIZKOR MEMORIAL BOOKLET – During the season of the High Holy Days, it is traditional to remember loved ones who have passed away. One special way to honor our beloved departed is to include them in our Yizkor Memorial Booklet that is distributed to all worshipers during Yizkor on Yom Kippur. A copy is also placed in the *Aron Kodesh*, the Holy Ark where the Torah scrolls are kept. A donation of \$9 per name is requested.



MISHEBERACH LIST - If there are individuals in your life who are ill, please consider adding their names to our Misheberach List, which will be printed in one of our Profiles during the year and will also be available to our clergy and worship leaders to pray for their healing. Please use the registration form to add names of your loved ones in need of healing. May they have healing along with all those in need of healing.

LULAV AND ETROG - It is traditional to bless and shake the lulav and etrog on each of the seven days of Sukkot, except Shabbat. We will have lulav and etrog sets available for use during Sukkot services on Monday, October 14 at B'nai Emunah and Tuesday, October 15 at Ner Tamid.



If you wish to order your own lulav and etrog to use in your home or sukkah, please use our High Holy Registration Form to order a set. Lulav and etrog orders may be picked up at B'nai Emunah between October 11 and 14.

Each set consists of

- an Israeli Etrog – citrus fruit that looks like a lemon, but has a special nub called pitom; and
- a lulav (palm branch) with its palm holder, together with hadassim (myrtle branches and leaves), and aravot (willow stems and leaves).

The lulav and etrog sets are kosher and available for the reduced price of \$42.

TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING OPTIONS

ROSH HASHANAH DAY 2 – Check High Holy Day Schedule for times and locations for worship and other activities on the Day 2 of Rosh Hashanah. If you choose to attend the Or Shalom Shofar Beach Service at Ocean Beach, you may use the parking opportunities described below.

Synagogue Address - Congregation B'nai Emunah is located at 3595 Taraval Street, corner of 46th Avenue, San Francisco.

Bus and Streetcar - The L Taraval streetcar and 18 - 46th Avenue bus stop near the synagogue.

Side Street Parking - There is no street cleaning on Erev Rosh Hashanah, Rosh Hashanah Day 1, Erev Yom Kippur or Yom Kippur Day, so please feel free to park on the numbered avenues, such as 46th or 47th or any other numbered avenue.

Taraval Street Parking - Starting this year, the 4-hour parking restriction on Taraval Street will not be enforced on Monday, September 30 for Rosh Hashanah and Wednesday, October 9 for Yom Kippur.

SF Zoo Overflow Lot – You may park in the S.F. Zoo Overflow Lot located on the south side of Sloat Blvd near Skyline Blvd. Parking in that lot is free of charge. The lot is unmarked and both driveways are open with no gates. We plan to tie balloons to the fence in a few places to help people find the lot.

Uber between B'nai Emunah and SF Zoo Overflow Lot – All B'nai Emunah members – AND all non-members who register for High Holy Days in advance – may use the B'nai Emunah Uber Business Account to take Uber from the SF Zoo Overflow Lot to the synagogue and back. You must have an Uber account to access our B'nai Emunah Uber Business Account.

Walking to the shul from SF Zoo Overflow Lot - To walk from the lot, cross Sloat Blvd. Walk toward your left along Sloat Blvd. Turn right on 42nd Ave. Turn left on Wawona St. Turn right on 46th Ave. Turn right on Taraval St. The shul entrance is on Taraval St.

Walking from shul to SF Zoo Overflow Lot - When you exit the front door of the shul, turn right on Taraval St. Turn right on 45th Ave. Turn Left on Wawona St. Turn right on 42nd Ave. When you get to Sloat Blvd, the SF Zoo Overflow Lot will be across the street and slightly to your left. There is a crosswalk to cross Sloat Blvd. around 41st Ave. and Yorba Lane.
